

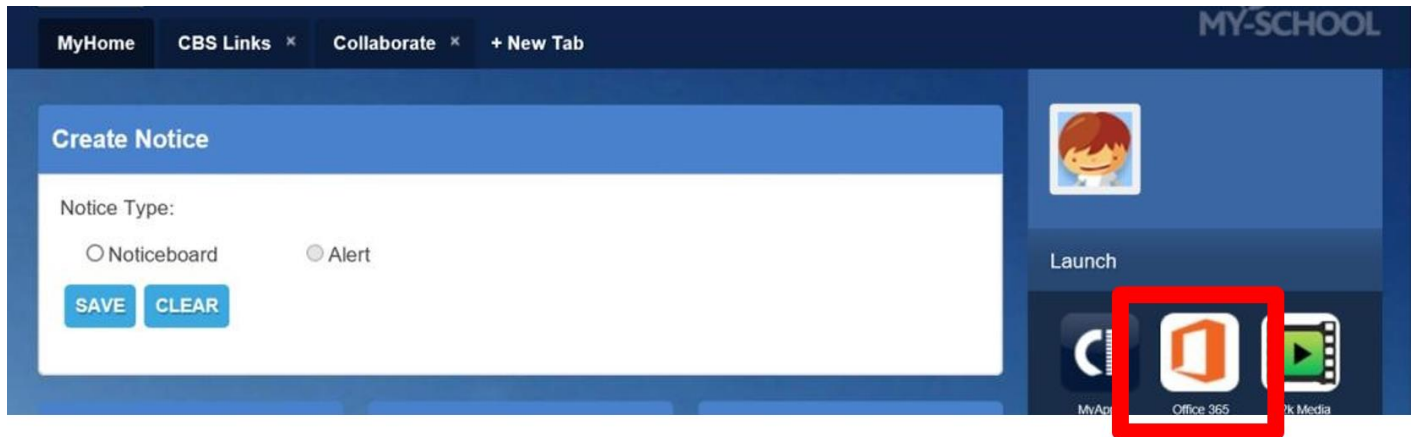

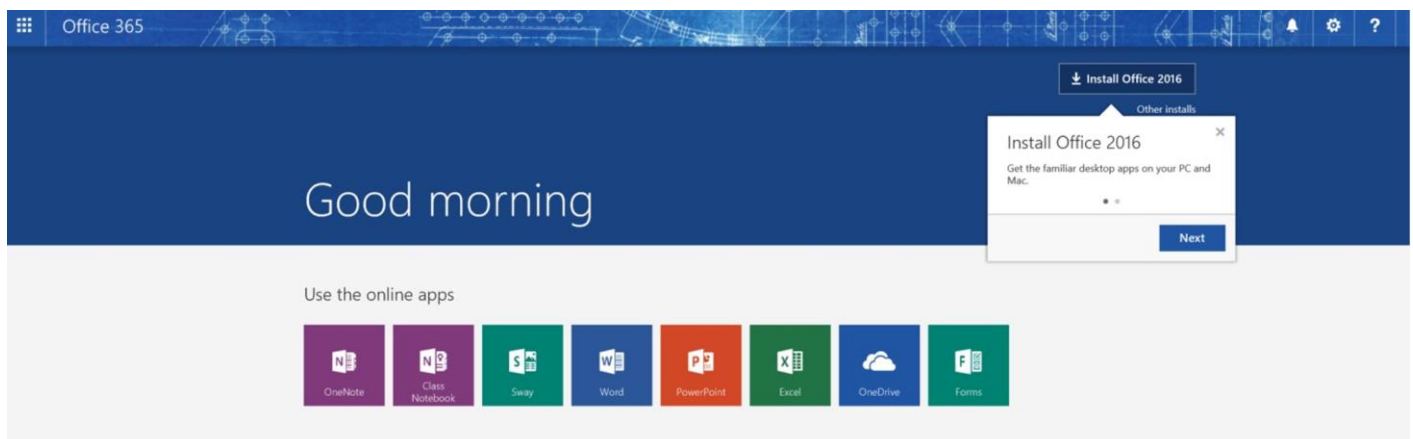
Using Office 365 for School Work

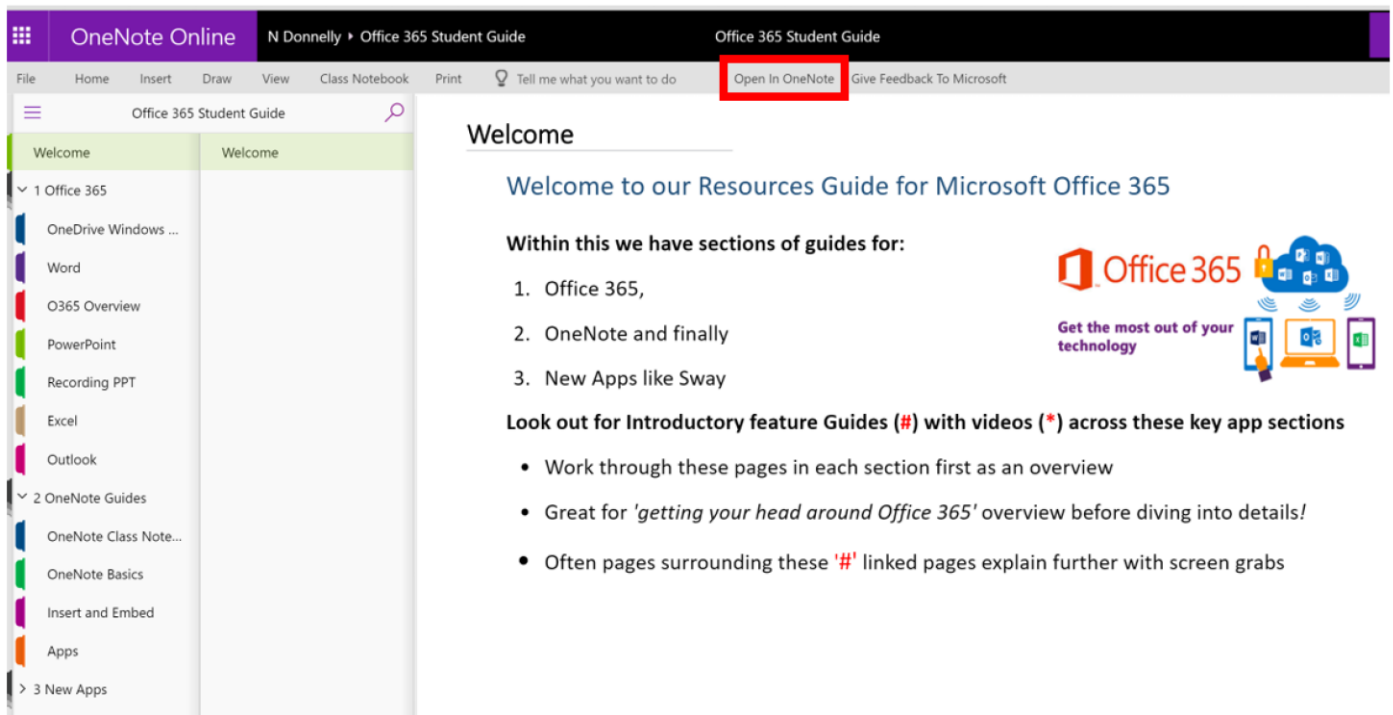
Tablet or Smartphone Apps

- If using a tablet or iPad or smartphone, use Microsoft Office Apps for OneDrive, Word, PowerPoint, OneNote, Excel etc. for easy access to your files and notes.
- These App versions are free from the Google Play or IOS App and Windows stores.
- To see your Class notes, resources etc and uploaded school files, go to App settings, Add Account (often referred to as Work or Business Account) and 'Sign In' with your C2K logon details - @c2ken.net
- Please ensure that in all App Settings, '*Sync over Wifi Only*' is ticked to save your data allowance.

Training yourself in Office 365

- It is laid out online in a folder style, with sections in a tabbed format as illustrated below.
- 'Open in OneNote' to have this locally available on your smartphone, tablet, PC etc. versions of OneNote



What is OneDrive?

OneDrive is an online storage service, integrated into Windows 10 and available as an app, which makes it simple to access and share your files and photos across your devices.

- Simply sign into the OneDrive App with your C2K logon details.
- When you make a change on one device, the updates are available on your other devices, so you can pick up right where you left off.
- In Windows 8 and 10, add files to OneDrive on your PC by dragging them into the OneDrive folder located on the left-hand side of File Explorer on a home PC (see above guide for more detail).
