



When: 29th – 30th August

Where: Magee Campus, Derry

Who: Year 13s who are studying at least one of these subjects: Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Maths (or have GCSE Additional Maths), Technology & Design, Engineering, Software Systems Development or ICT. *NB. Students offering ICT, should also be studying a Science/Maths A-Level.*

What: This year the workshop will have an emphasis on Engineering. It will involve a range of team-based project activities using, for example, Raspberry Pi, or creating a Computer-Aided Design (CAD) model. It will give students an insight into university life, as well as assisting them in making informed decisions regarding their upcoming UCAS applications.
