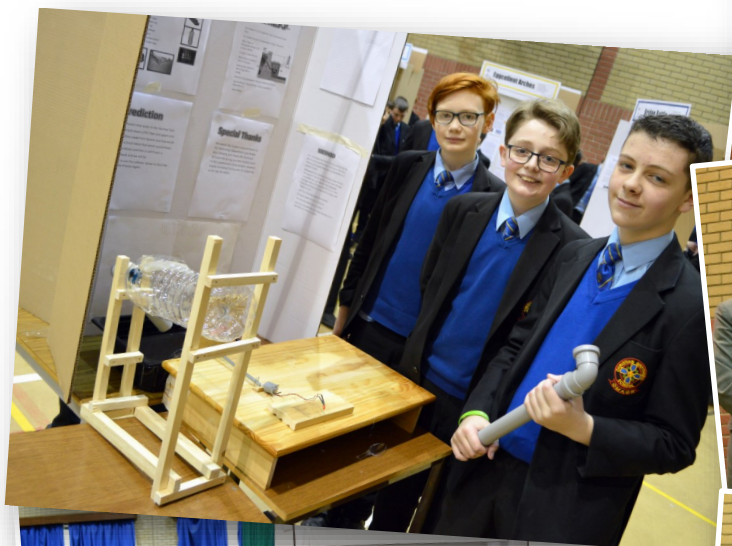


## Scifest 2018

## Tyrone GAA Gaeltacht Scholarships 2018

The highly successful Tyrone GAA Gaeltacht Grants scheme will proceed again in 2018, 'Bliain na Gaeilge'.

Members of CLG will be invited to submit applications to the County for the grant aid. The scheme will open on 3<sup>rd</sup> April and the close of applications will be Friday 11<sup>th</sup> May at 5.00 pm. Applications can only be accepted from current registered members of GAA clubs in Tír Eoghain. Application forms will be available through Club Secretaries, or from the reception at Garvaghey plus it will be available to download via the Resources & Downloads section on the Tír Eoghain website.
