Creative Writing Competition

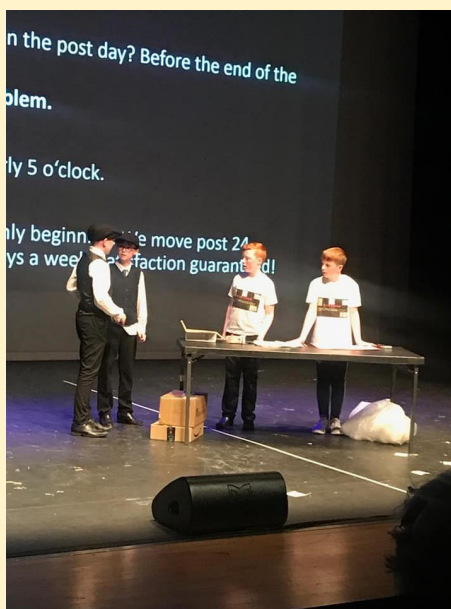

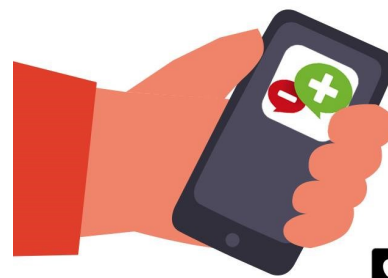
Big Book Bonanza
