\*Preference will be given to candidates with a minimum Grade B in Maths

Essential Skills, Key Skills or City & Guilds, at the appropriate level, will also be considered as acceptable equivalents.

#### **Department for the Economy Eligibility Criteria**

Applicants should be aware that the selection of successful candidates will be made in accordance with the eligibility criteria for the funding of the ApprenticeshipsNI 2017 programme, as set out by the Department for the Economy. Candidates who already hold an Aeronautical Engineering Framework Level 3 qualification will not be eligible for funding and will therefore not be eligible to apply for a place on the programme.
