- Senior Trad group: 1<sup>st</sup> place in Grupa Ceol competition














## Strule Arts Exhibition Visit

Last Friday some of our Year 11 GCSE Art students visited the Strule Arts Centre to see the work of local artist Sarah Kilfeder in her exhibition titled 'The Search for Light in the Darkness'. Sarah met with our pupils and spoke to them about her journey as an artist, explaining her techniques, sources of inspiration and interest in eco-art and "theraplay". Sarah was a previous member of the Turner Prize-winning art group, Array Studios. She also established the 'Creative Drop Stop' in Gallows Hill Community House in 2018, where she facilitated art classes for adults and children. Our students were inspired by her playful and expressive use of colour as well as her approach to representation of architecture and nature in her work and they hope to incorporate these concepts into their own work in the future.









## Track & Field Success for CBS Athletes

The E district schools track & field athletics championships for Inter & Senior age level was held this week at the Peacelink in Clones. Ciaran McCarroll took bronze in the 800m, time 2min:06.

Rory Dolan had a well earned bronze in the 1500m in the inter boys final.

Ben Kelly made his comeback to the track and certainly blew the cobwebs off his running spikes with a very close photo finish 2nd place in the 100m inter boys sprint final.

Liam Griffiths clinched bronze in the 200m final.

Both Harley Patton and Cormac Cunningham missed a podium finish in the very quick 400m time trial.

The inter boys 4 x 100m relay team-Ben Kelly, Kevin McAnualla, Liam Griffiths and Harley Patton took silver medals in a very exciting inter boys final which St Michael's Enniskillen won.

Blaine Lynch left the best to last and claimed gold in the Senior boys javelin with a huge throw of 47m.

Our athletes who have made the podium today have qualified to compete in the Ulster schools finals on 20th May at Antrim forum.
