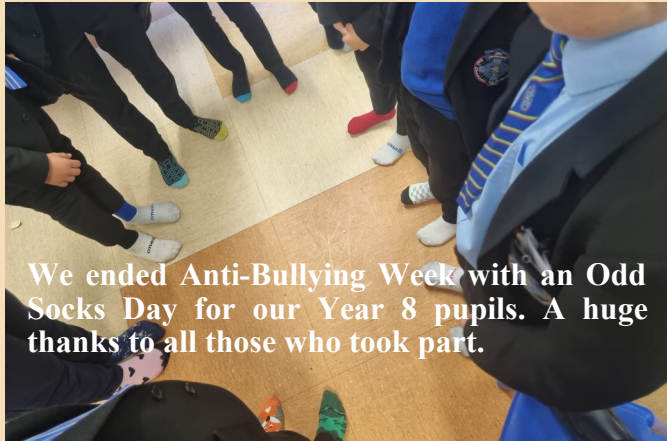

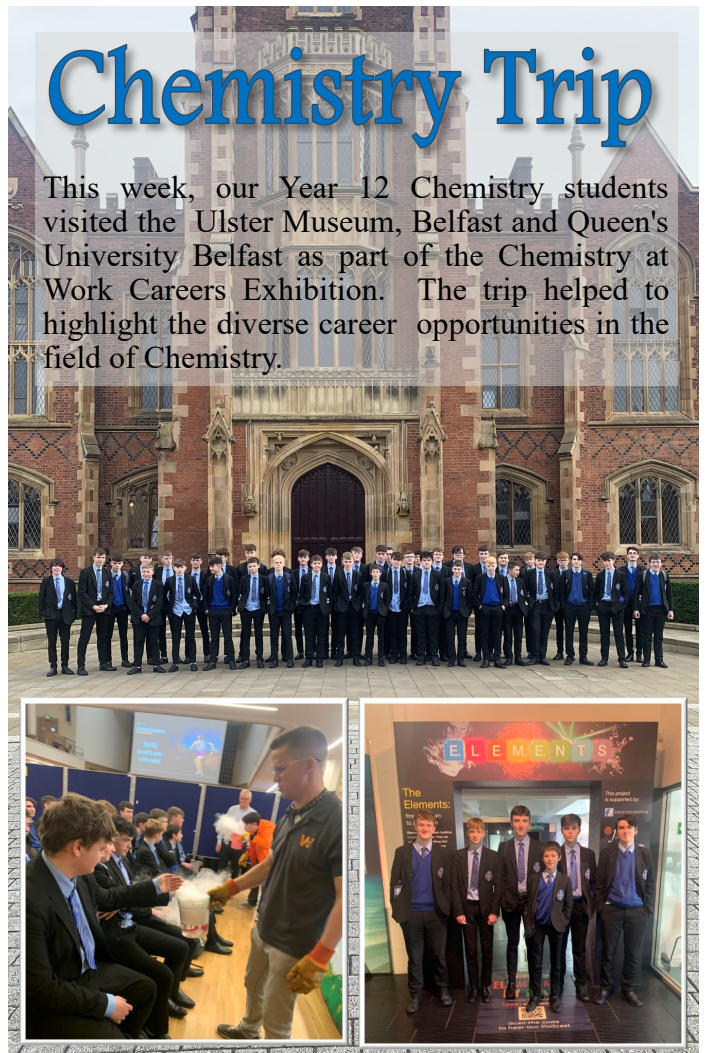
BBC Young Reporter

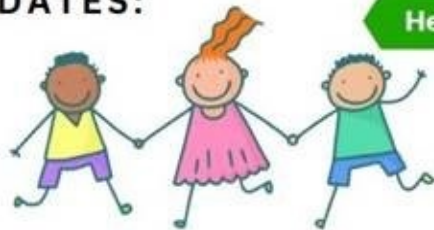
Chemistry Trip
